The Warehouse and Storage Apprenticeship framework is primarily targeted towards learners operating in a workplace where goods and services are supplied to other businesses, often operated from depots or warehouses.

The programme prepares learners for roles such as:

- Stock control/ replenish assistant
- Stores Assistant
- Warehouse worker/manager

Level 2 Certificate in Warehousing and Storage

Course Delivery

This programme will primarily be delivered through 1-to-1 sessions with a member of the ALS delivery team, using a mixture of face-to-face and remote learning sessions. An ALS assessor will meet with the learner, either in the workplace or through digital means (for example, Microsoft Teams) once a month for approximately two hours to support progress.

Learners will also be set tasks to complete between each visit, which are tailored, to the different needs of each learner and the workplace activities they are involved with.

Ideally, learners will have a camera on their computer to allow some online sessions and to capture evidence for their portfolios. Knowledge elements can be captured through written or typed work or captured through verbal discussion.

Qualification Structure Summary

The Level 2 Certificate in Warehousing and Storage consists of 2 mandatory units with a total of 7 credits that must be achieved.

Please note: at least 26 credits must be achieved. Unit rules of combination.

- Mandatory Units (Learners must achieve all 2 units) 7 credits.
- Optional units that must be achieved 26 credits.

What you will learn

This programme is made up of a mixture of mandatory units (these have to be completed by all learners as part of the qualification) and optional units (we will work with the apprentice to decide what units are relevant to their role, and their business).
